MIDIV Convention Report

Cheryl and Dick Faxon represented Ozark Mountain Region at the SCCA Midwest Division Convention at the Lake of the Ozarks in mid November. The highlight of the convention for Dick and Cheryl was the Executive Committee meeting - well, Cheryl's highlight actually was a shopping trip to nearby outlet stores - wherein the 2004 divisional competition schedule was ratified. Dick reports final approval was delayed a bit when three different Regions asked to host the MidAm "bonus" race, but the controversy was quickly resolved in favor of MidSouth Region. The divisional calendar appears on page 7 of this issue.

The Executive Committee approved several rules affecting the various MIDIV road racing championships. Certainly the most far reaching is a requirement that all of the division's tracks must employ a transponder timing & scoring system in 2004. Transponder systems are common in other Divisions, in professional racing, and even in vintage/historic racing.

The Committee established an IT7 class within the MidAm Road Racing Championship for first generation Mazda RX7s and also created a Club Formula Continental class for vehicles ten years old and older. After much discussion and a contentious vote, an approved tire list - Toyo Proxes RA-1, Kumho Victoracer V700 and Ecsta V700, Hankook Ventus Z211 - was ratified for the SpecMiata class. And the Committee approved the stipulation that 1) the MidAm "bonus" race must be scheduled after the *Runoffs* and 2) the "bonus" race will rotate to a different track every two years.

Several awards were announced at the banquet which concluded the convention. Kansas Region's Dale Smith, an RX7 racer in the MidAm's E Production class, won the *Workers' Choice* award, Southern Illinois Region's Chris Albin took home the MidAm "Driver of the Year" trophy, Monica Shaw from Des Moines Valley Region was named MIDIV "Worker of the Year," and MidSouth Region's Maureen Wheeler was presented the *England-Stipe Award*, MIDIV's highest honor, for her long service to the Division's racing program.

The 2004 MIDIV Convention will be hosted by Wichita Region.

Awards Banquet Kicks Off 2004

OMR's first event of the new year is our annual <u>Awards Banquet</u> scheduled for Saturday, January 17 at the *Riverside Inn* north of Ozark, MO. (See page 3 for complete details.) The sixteen class champions in OMR's 2003 SOLO II Championship will receive awards, and the gigantic "Autocrosser of the Year" traveling trophy will be presented to Sam Henry for the third year in a row. Let's hope he brings his saucy wife, Jennifer. (And incidentally, you single guys bring chicks; chicks dig awards ceremonies!)

National road racing awards will go to Loren Moore (1st - Touring 1) and Chuck Leighton (3rd - G Production) in recognition of their final rankings in MIDIV's national points competition. *MidAm Championship* trophies will be presented to Dick Faxon (1st -SpecMiata,) Chris Brannon (1st - Touring 2,) Rick Carr (2nd -GT2,) and Shane Bennoch (3rd - Formula Continental.)
