It's Election Time Again

Not the Bush vs Kerry battle.....it's time for the annual election of the Region's Board of Directors. In accordance with OMR's <u>Bylaws</u>, **four members of the Board must be elected each fall.** Ballots for this election will be mailed in November with *The BLAT* (to be published soon after our Nov. 7th autocross.) The ballots will be counted at our Dec. 7th monthly meeting.

Each year's Board of Directors is composed of seven members who name the Region's Officers (from among themselves) and oversee the Region's business and events. At the end of the year, three of the Directors "carry over" to the succeeding year's Board and the remaining four Directors retire or seek re-election. **Volunteers are needed <u>now</u> to run for these four positions on the Regional Board.** The <u>Bylaws</u> stipulate that candidates must have been SCCA members <u>for at least one year</u>. Obviously, candidates also must be willing to donate the time and effort necessary to make OMR's events fun and successful.

The current Directors are: Rick Carr, Regional Executive; Phil Fanning, Assistant R,.E.; Jeff Moore, Treasurer; Sam Henry, Secretary; and Erik Anderson, Chris Simons, Derek Gresham. Who the "carry over" Directors will be is unknown at the moment. How many of the remaining four Directors will seek re-election also is unknown, but one or two are likely to retire. **Here is your opportunity to become more involved in the Region's affairs and to influence the Region's focus and events.** Do you have ideas which might make our events more fun or more attractive? Are you able to lend a hand in the scheduling and management of autocrosses and rallies? Do you have time to help run the Club? People, it's a volunteer organization....enjoyment of Regional events brings with it the responsibility to give something back if you are able to do so.

Our Region's oldest event - <u>the Halloween Rally</u> - is scheduled for <u>Saturday, Oct. 30</u>. Once again, <u>Mike Eden will serve as Rally-</u> <u>master</u> and he's planned a traditional, gimmick rally to get competing teams from the starting point to the traditional, post event *Bonfire Party*. 2005 Midwest Division Schedule

Next year's Divisional Calendar appears on Page 5 of this issue. Take it with a grain of salt and remember it's titled "planning schedule." The 2005 schedule will be made final at the Midwest Division Convention in Tulsa next month. You can expect some additions to the schedule once the final version has been posted. (Autocrossers will note that only two Divisional SOLO II events are listed but at least four *SOLOTIME* events have been run the past few years.)

MIDIV's annual Convention is scheduled for Friday & Saturday, November 12th & 13th at the new *Cherokee Casino Resort* at I-44 & 193rd E. Ave. on the eastern edge of Tulsa. Registration and a "welcoming reception" are planned for Friday evening (6:00 to 10:00 PM.) The meetings and training sessions begin at 7:30 AM Saturday and conclude with a banquet Saturday evening.

'04 Autocross Season Nears Conclusion

(First, go back and re-read "ATTENTION: Autocrossers" at the bottom of the first column.) OMR's 2004 Solo II season is nearing its conclusion with just two events remaining. Ten autocrosses were scheduled this year, and, since members competing for the various class championships can count only their "best six" results, many class titles already have been wrapped up. Here's a rundown.

In the "lock the door, turn out the lights, take it to the bank" category, those with six (or more) wins - and thus a maximum of 90 points - are <u>Gregg McNabb/C4</u> Corvette in A Stock, <u>Matt Searing/Audi S4</u> in D Stock, <u>Sam Henry/Mazda Miata in E Stock, Brad Eldred/Celica GT in G Stock, Forrest Tindall/Porsche 912 in H Stock, LyndellPickett/ Mazda RX7 in C Street Prepared, <u>Mark Foley/Camaro Z28</u> in ESP, <u>Raymond Talley/</u>Toyota MR2 in SM 2, <u>Bob Heisler</u>/Neon ACR in STS, and <u>Randy McCall</u>/ Subaru WRX in ST whatever-class-he's-really-supposed-to-be-in. Congratulations, gentlemen, but we still want to see you at Price Cutter Park on Oct. 24th and Nov. 7th!</u>

In the "very likely, yes it's true, don't lose any sleep" category are: <u>Charles Trebilcock</u>/Mustang in F Stock who has "qualified" by running four times, has four wins in the class and whose current score (60 pts) can't be matched with just two events remaining; <u>Ron Rinke</u>/BMW 2002 in F Street Prepared with the same scenario as Trebilcock but with five wins (75 pts;) and <u>Robert Marsh</u>/FVee in F Modified who now has 87 pts (five wins, one 2nd) and can't be topped by arch rival <u>David Small</u>/F Vee (two wins, four 2nds)

From here on, things get sticky....in B Stock, <u>Jim Moore</u>/Honda S2000 has 45 pts (three wins) but hasn't run four times, while <u>Josef</u> <u>Welsh</u>/MazdaSpeed Miata has run only twice but could trump Jim's score by winning on the 24th and Nov. 7th. Bottom line...Jim needs to run one more time and win, while Josef needs to run two more times and win both. Maybe.....

In C Stock, <u>Pat Mitchell</u>/Mazda Miata abandoned the class after winning three times. <u>Lester Henry</u>/Mazda Miata has since collected three wins. Thus, both have the same score but neither has qualified by running in the class four times.

In BSP, regular entrants <u>Mark Rountree</u>/Corvette and <u>Dave Acuff</u>/ Corvette could end the season with identical scores - five wins, one 2nd. If that happens, Mark would win via the tie-breaker, and, thus, has the edge at the moment.

DSP is a mystery to me. <u>Nick Taliaferro</u>/Saab Viggen would seem to have the upper hand with four wins (60 pts) but - if Nick misses the last two events - someone else (most likely Skyler Spartan or Chris Simons) could better his score with six lesser results. Nick, bail me out by showing up on Oct. 24th!

And finally, Street Modified where <u>David Quinonez</u>/Eagle Talon is nearing a class title. He leads the class right now, but <u>Chris Conant</u>/ BMW M3 (four wins, 60 pts) could return and win the last two events thereby posting a perfect score of six wins, 90 pts.
